WaterCare aims to provide support through:

- \* drop in days at the local Job centre plus, community centres, libraries, children centres and housing offices;
- \* raising awareness through organisations and charities, so they can then take the information out to the community or refer into the service;
- \* working with housing

associations to visit properties door- to-door with their teams, offering face-to-face support and identifying any additional support needed; and

- \* home visits.
