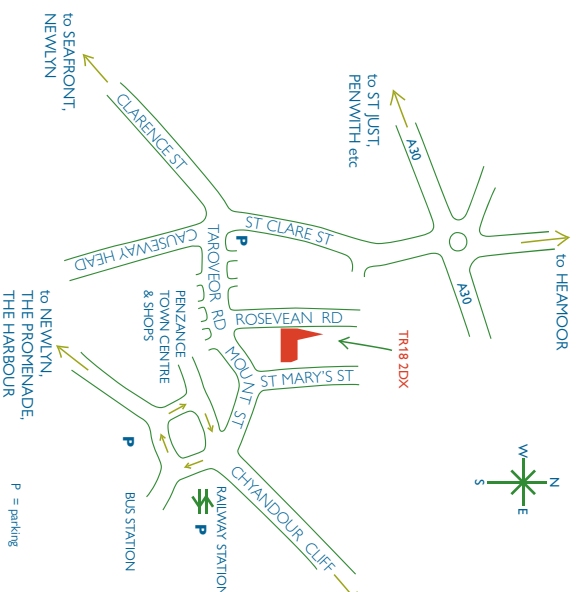

◆ **Monday 18 May**

**BASIC APOLOGETICS** with **Mike Collins**

In this talk you will learn how to give a basic defence of your faith. It is important for all Christians to feel confident when defending their faith with so many competing world views.

◆ **Tuesday 19 May**

**ALEXANDRA ROAD to CHAPEL STREET**

with **Val Thomas**. An historic audio-visual stroll looking at how the buildings have changed over the years.

**From STONE AGE to CHRISTIANITY**

Local teacher **James Clayton** will explore the ancient roots of West Cornwall's past, from humankind's earliest presence in this part of the world, to the first arrival of Christianity on these shores.

**J S Courtney** wrote the *Guide to Penzance and its Neighbourhood* (1845), and was one of the leading Penzance antiquarians of his day. In the next generation, his two daughters, **Margaret & Louise**, struck out on their own, with different but notable outcomes. This talk will explore their work, lives and personalities.

**PENZANCE COPPER** with **Robert Padfield**

A deep dive into the creative space behind Penzance Copper: the techniques, inspirations and meanings that go into the finished pieces of copper work made on Rosevean Road.
